

Dynamics of Aquatic Warbler population in Lithuania

Only from 2004 Aquatic Warbler counting is taking place regularly in 3 places: 1) In the Eastern shore of the Curonian Lagoon in Tyrai mire and in flooded meadows of Svencelė; 2) in Nemunas delta (Kniaupas bay, surroundings of Krokų Lanka, flooded meadows of Šyša, Sausgalviai, Tulkiaragė, Uostadvaris, Vorusnė and Alka polder meadows, in the old riverbed of Minija); 3) Zuvintas Biosphere Reserve

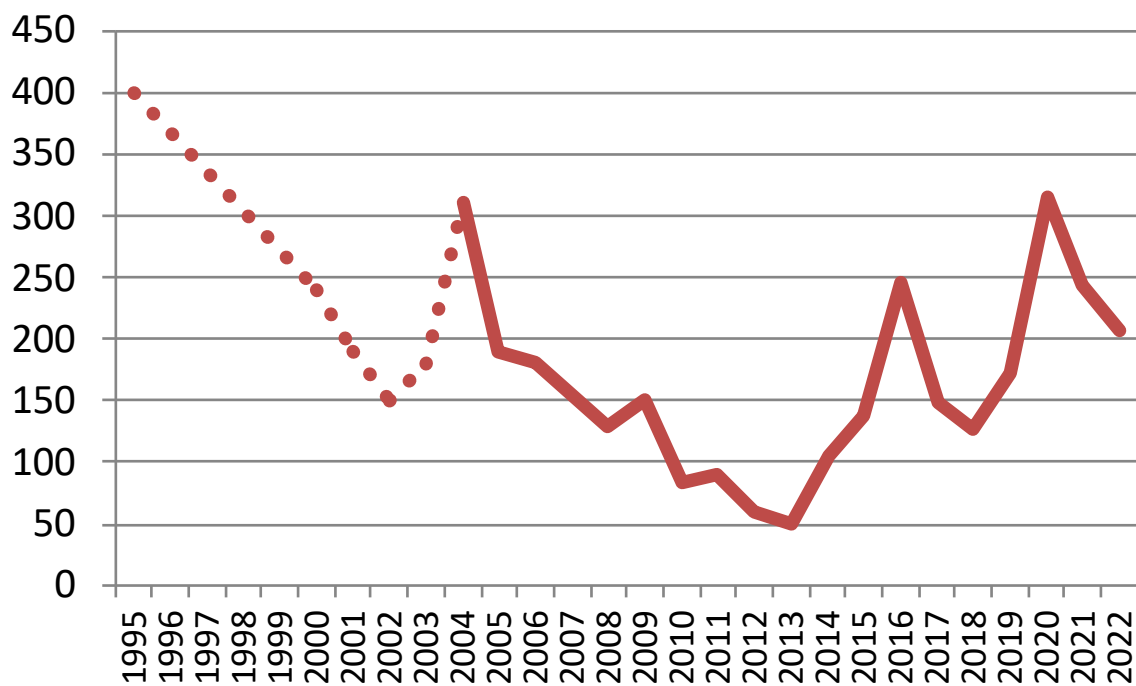
